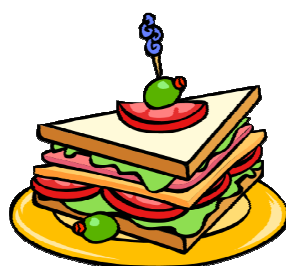
Welcome back to Term 3. I hope everyone had a nice break.
