### Dear Parents / Caregivers and Musicians

A festival for instrumental and choral students from the Bramble Bay cluster of primary schools is to be held from the July 30 to August 2 to showcase the wonderful musical experiences our children enjoy in Bramble Bay. The festival will be non-residential and will run from approximately 9:00 am – usually 2.30 pm each day.

### ELIGIBILITY

Students who nominate for the Concert Band or String Orchestra part of the festival must be present for their sectional day, their full rehearsal day and perform in the concert. No exceptions will be made.

#### Band

Students who have completed up to Page 22 in "Standard of Excellence", "Essential Elements" – Page 15, "Tradition of Elements" – page 22 or their equivalent method book (Commenced Level 1.4 of Education Queensland's Instrumental Music Curriculum Guide) and who have a positive attitude, good attendance and behaviour within their school programs will be nominated by their instrumental teacher. (Usually this is students in their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of playing or above). **Those children who will be included in the Honours Music Camp, should not be included.**

#### Strings

Students who are in at least their 3<sup>rd</sup> year (or above) of playing a stringed instrument are eligible to attend.

#### Choir

The choir section of BBSMF is **only** open to students from schools that have already indicated to the BBSMF coordinators that their school will be participating in 2018. If you are uncertain if your school is participating, please ask your choir teacher. It is recommended that only children in Yrs 4,5, and 6 participate as it is long day. Due to the large number of schools participating, it may be necessary to limit the number of choristers from each school to 35.

### COSTS

The cost of participating in the festival will be \$10.00 total, regardless of how many days you are involved (if paying by cheque, please make cheque payable to your school) to cover costs.

### PERMISSION AND MEDICAL FORM
