St Patricks College access

Please advised parents that there is ONLY street parking at St Patrick's. Bald Hills State School access

The best access for [Bald Hills SS](#) Hall is through the pedestrian gate on Old Gympie Road near the pedestrian lights. Due to the large number of children attending on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday, it will be necessary to time the breaks at a slightly different time than the breaks at either school. It will be necessary for the children to be supervised during the breaks. At BHSS the children will be able to sit in the covered area opposite the hall, or outside the hall on the concrete to eat & play on the oval adjacent to the Hall. No food or drink (other than water) is permitted in the hall at either school.

At BHSS there is a kitchen available with a microwave, fridge & jug/kettle available for use by the teachers/supervisors.

Due to the floor covering at BHSS, it is requested that ladies do NOT wear shoes with stiletto heels.

FINAL CONCERT

The final Concert will be held on Thursday in the [St Patrick's College Auditorium](#) at 7 pm. Band and Strings are to arrive by 6 pm at the Callen Centre to off load instrument cases, sign-in and then be directed to their warm-up areas to warm up.

Please advise parents that there will be hot food available from 5.30pm to 7.00pm in the courtyard. This money goes to St. Pat's. Please remember there is no food or drink (other than water) permitted in the Hall.

Please advise parents prior to attending the concert, there is an admission fee of **\$10.00 per family or \$5.00 per single entry, payable at the door** and there will be a raffle (with lots of prizes especially if every school provides a prize). Please advise parents that the money from the Tickets AND the raffle will be coming to Bramble Bay to assist with the payment of conductors etc.

It is requested that the children wear their school uniform during the day and their performance uniform for the concert on the Thursday night.

A printed program will be available on the evening. Please have notes regarding your school emailed to [Marion](#) by 3.00pm on Wednesday.
